Details of the Position

Part-time, hourly position

20 hours per week, with specific hours on Sundays (8 AM – 1 PM every week and 4:30 PM – 7 PM twice a month), and the other hours worked on a flexible, yet consistent schedule.

Mission

The role of the Nursery Coordinator is to glorify God by maintaining a safe and welcoming nursery environment for the tiniest members of our community. Supporting the Director of Kids' Small Groups, the nursery coordinator will maintain responsibility for the nursery space, supplies, curriculum and staff (both paid and volunteer,) with a goal of providing easily accessible, meaningful opportunities for our children and families to grow as disciples of Jesus.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Oversee the staffing and equipping of the nursery rooms.
- Recruit, hire, and supervise all paid nursery employees.
- Supervise nursery volunteers.
- Insure that those who serve in the nursery have met all requirements for serving at Restoration under our *5 Steps for Keeping Kids Safe @ Restoration* policy and are current in their child safety training.
- Track of all those who need child safety training to insure that they are current.
- Arrange for childcare for events at the request of other ministries.
- Review time sheets for nursery employees and submit them to the Director of Operations on a bi-monthly basis.
- Utilize database and maintain records related to all children, families, and volunteers in children's ministry
- Order and maintain supplies for the nursery.
- Maintain age-appropriate toys in the nursery.
- Oversee the cleaning and sanitizing of toys and equipment in the nursery.
- Insure that the nursery's laundry is done weekly.
- Engage children in the nursery in age-appropriate and developmentally-appropriate activities.
- Review and prepare nursery curriculum on a weekly basis.
- Oversee the preparation of meal calendars for those families with a new baby.



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- Solicit and curate pregnancy prayer requests and communicate with moms and intercessors.
- Assist Director of Kids' Small Groups in coordinating special events and seasonal activities.

- Natural ability for organization and creating electronic systems for capturing, tracking, and maintaining data.
